

It's not a thick book.-I wish it was thicker because this artist's skills is phenomenal, especially his water and water reflection techniques. Each artist have their own expertise and for me, Mr. Dowden's water painting technique takes the prize. This book focuses on his developed methods to painting "water," not so much on equipments or tools like a beginner's book. This book is not for a beginner's--(but you lose nothing from having it)--book per se; it's very helpful for painters who want to paint water scenes better, differently, through different techniques, trying a different style, etc. I say this book is for people who know or have basic painting skills and is seeking ways to improve, enhance, further one's talent. The step by step instructions are clearly illustrated and explained. I really, really enjoyed this book. What I find amazing is as Mr. Dowden builds on his colors, you don't see how the jumble of paint could product or be made into the intended result.
